Three positions will be open for scholars and researchers in the social sciences or humanities with a focus on media, communication, and culture. Each fellowship will last one month during the 2026–2027 academic year.

CONDITIONS

During their one-month stay, visiting faculty will receive a **stipend of 3,000 euros (gross)** and are expected to:

- provide a single seminar or lecture in an active course.
- actively contribute to the research community they will join, delivering at least an academic lecture which will be open to the entire Department.

Visitors will be responsible for securing their own accommodation, as well as covering their own travel expenses.

Visiting faculty will be given access to an office space on campus and to the research activity and events program of our Department

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be current full-time permanent faculty members at their home University.

APPLICATION

Applications should be submitted by email to Prof. Christopher Anderson at christopher.anderson@unimi.it and must include the following documents, drawn up in English:

- A statement of interest for the position, including research project to be undertaken at Milan School of Media and Communication (MSMC) and specifics (ex: proposed dates of stay)
- A full CV, including list of publications

The School of Media and Communication (MSMC) conducts research and teaches in multiple languages university (Italian & English), Italian is not required this position, but knowledge of one of the two languages is essential.

A selection committee appointed by the Milan School of Media and Communication will assess the applications. Decisions will be communicated to applicants following each review round.

DEADLINES

Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis until all three fellowship positions have been filled.
